

CONNECTING STUDENTS TO NUTRITIOUS FOOD IN SCHOOL AND AT HOME

It's hard to ensure that students are receiving the food they need to fuel their studies, but there's a simple way your school can help. Include a checkbox on the Free and Reduced-Price Lunch form that prompts a referral to our Food Resource Hotline. Once Hunger Free Colorado receives the referral, food resource navigators reach out and help families apply for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and connect them to nearby food resources. Students participating in SNAP are automatically certified for free school meals.
